

Nonresident Student Enrollment Capacity

USD 249 will have limited capacity to accept nonresident students for the 2024-2025 school year. Based on the projected enrollment and capacity to operate effectively, USD 249 will accept nonresident students as outlined in the table below. The district reserves the right to assign nonresident students to a school and the process for selection is outlined on the application. Students living outside of the USD 249 boundary must formally apply for nonresident enrollment and use the application linked on the website which will be available on or before June 1, 2024. Applications will also be available in each school office. The completed application must be received by no later than June 30, 2024. Applications may also be picked up and returned to the USD 249 District Office at 208 S. Cayuga St. All questions about nonresident enrollment shall be directed to the building principals.
